



It promotes the use of the Maine wilderness for recreation and environmentally responsible land use practices. JMG certification lays the groundwork for later training and certification for a Maine Trip Leader permit, but also provides skills for a lifetime for outdoors enthusiasts. Using current philosophies in outdoor living, the program is unique to Maine and is offered by various Maine summer camps.
