

Why a Maine Summer Camp?



There's no place quite like Maine

For more than 120 years, families have come to appreciate Maine's summer camps as a haven for kids to experience natural beauty and have their emotional, social, physical and cognitive needs met by highly qualified adults.

Maine is more than a place —it's a feeling you get as soon as you arrive. Suddenly, the air's a little fresher, the pines taller, the lakes clearer. You can hear the essence of Maine in the cry of a loon, taste it in a fresh-caught trout, and watch the sun rise a little earlier in Maine than anywhere else in America. The fact is, there's more of Maine, and more to Maine, than the rest of New England combined: deeper forests, bigger lakes, more rugged mountains, longer rivers and more than 3000 miles of shoreline.

For example, recent research has shown that 95 percent of science is learned outside the classroom. Camps also are an ideal setting for fostering social and emotional learning, which is essential to the healthy development of children.

Maine Summer Camps offer wonderful, structured activities to meet campers' individual interests, with ample time for kids to just be kids —to engage spontaneously in games, free play, discussions and simply hang out together.

Established in 1937 by the Maine State Legislature, the JMG Program is an outdoors skills program for youth ages 9-18. It promotes the use of the Maine wilderness for recreation and environmentally responsible land use practices. JMG certification lays the groundwork for later training and certification for a Maine Trip Leader permit, but also provides skills for a lifetime for outdoors enthusiasts. Using current philosophies in outdoor living, the program is unique to Maine and is offered by various Maine summer camps.
